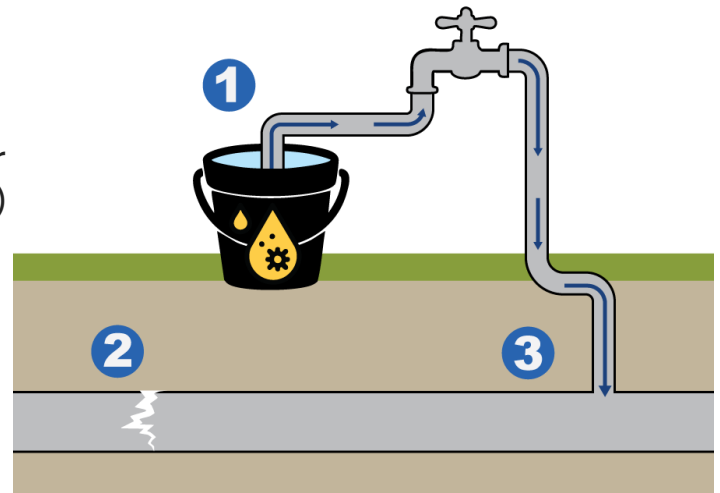
WHAT IS A BACKFLOW?

Backflow happens when water flows the wrong way and flows back into the drinking water system. This can pull or push on-site contaminants, like dirt, chemicals, or fertilizers into the clean water supply. Backflow prevention devices stop that from happening and help keep our community's drinking water safe from on-site hazards

WHAT IS A CROSS CONNECTION?

A cross connection is a link between your drinking water and a non-potable (unsafe) source, such as:

- Hoses in pools, buckets, or ponds
- Irrigation or sprinkler systems
- Equipment connected to water lines



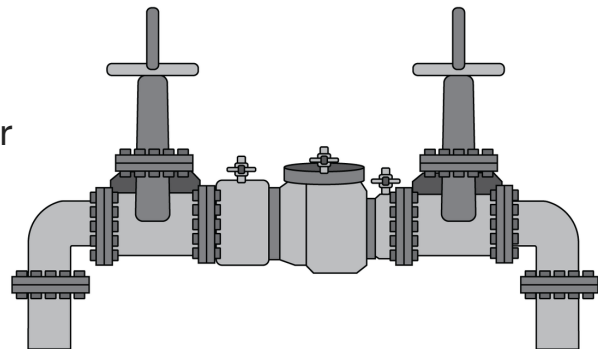
WHY IT MATTERS

Backflow can introduce harmful substances like:

- Chemicals and fertilizers
- Bacteria and other contaminants

HOW YOU CAN HELP

- Don't submerge hoses in contaminated water
- Install hose vacuum breakers outdoors
- Use proper backflow prevention devices
- Test required devices annually



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
