

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-35**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SAN MIGUEL COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT ADOPTING PROPOSED UTILITY BILLING LATE FEES AND COLLECTION PROCEDURES

WHEREAS, the San Miguel Community Services District ("District") desires to establish governing policies and procedures for utility billing late fees and collection procedures for utility billing late charges and to establish a formal collection and appeal procedure for utility billing late charges ("Policies"); and

WHEREAS, the District Board of Directors ("Board") has determined that these governing policies and procedures should be established with formal processes to appeal a utility billing statement, and to allow the District to recover appropriate late fee charges through a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 998, which takes effect on April 1, 2020, requires the District to implement additional policies and procedures as it pertains to the Policies; and

**WHEREAS,** per Board direction, staff will roll out the requirements of Senate Bill 998, with a full compliance date of April 1, 2020; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Directors of the San Miguel Community Services District hereby determines the need formal procedures and policies do hereby approve and adopt as shown as Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** this Resolution shall be in effect upon adoption of this resolution by the Board and remain in full force and effect until rescinded or replaced by a Board resolution or ordinance.
